- 1. Find your XM receiver per the instructions and unplug the 16 pin connector. Plug that connector on the body harness into the Aux In harness. Push the connector STRAIGHT into the female mating connector. It should feel right—don't force it—you can bend a pin if you don't push it straight in.
- 2. Plug the other 16 pin connector into the XM receiver. Again, do not force the connector.
- 3. Plug the 3.5mm (1/8") plug into your music device.
- 4. Press the XM1/2 button on your radio. You should now hear your audio from your music device instead of XM. Enjoy your music.
